Madrigal Family Winery is located on Highway 29, between Calistoga and St. Helena. The winery is situated on 40 acres of estate vineyards. The Madrigal winery produces about 6,000 cases of wine a year, specializing in Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah, Gewurztraminer, Zinfandel, Sauvignon Blanc and small lots of single vineyard and estate wines.

Since the late 1930's, three generations of the Madrigal family have farmed some of Napa Valley's finest vineyards. The family history is a constant source of inspiration, and guides us in our wine making now. Today, the company is run by Chris Madrigal, the founder's grandson, and vintner of Madrigal Family Winery.

TASTING NOTES: Our 2013 Petite Sirah is dark and inky in color, and introduces aromas of dark berries and dark chocolate with hints of espresso. The dark fruit theme continues onto the palate with accented notes of plum, blackberry and dark current. Round tannins take you into a smooth, long finish. Smoked meats, BBQ and any hearty dish makes a great pairing.



TASTING NOTES: A deep red color, typical of this grape, with dark violet hues. The aromas are powerful and expressive, with cassis, plum, blackberry and cherry that complement notes of chocolate, pepper, herbs and subtle earth notes. The full mouthfeel is complex, with good structure and ripe, round tannins that lead to a long finish.
