ANDREW RICH WINES 2014 'GLACIAL' COLUMBIA VALLEY, WASHINGTON

Andrew Rich has a long and storied career in wine. Starting out as a magazine editor in NYC, he decided to change his course by enrolling in school in Burgundy for winemaking. Coming back to the states and landing in California, Andrew caught a great opportunity with the funky and offbeat Bonny Doon Vineyard in Santa Cruz. He worked together there for 5 vintages getting practical experience and honing his style. It was here that Andrew developed a penchant for Rhone wines, which have become the focus of a serious following in the wine world in addition to his iconic Pinot noir. Coming to Oregon was another roll of the dice that panned out well. He casually accepted an invitation from his only fellow American schoolmate from Burgundy and fell in love with the Pacific Northwest.

TASTING NOTES: Dark purple, almost inky in the glass, 2014 Glacial is filled with blackberry, peppercorn, and olive tapenade. The Syrah component brings meaty/sanguine weight along with classic garrigue – Grenache provides lifted cherry and plum – Mourvedre adds additional structure and knits each flavor together.

Composition: 52% Syrah, 26% Mourvedre, 22% Grenache



TASTING NOTES: Grown primarily in the cool-climate Coombsville appellation of the Napa Valley, the 2014 Headwaters is a vibrant, richly layered wine. Proximity to the San Pablo Bay imparts spicy aromatic and flavor complexities, while the gravel and volcanic-rock strewn soils contribute to the mineral notes that roll on the palate and finish. A focused purity of gorgeous red and blue fruits infuse a core of currant and pomegranate flavors. This is an elegant wine that despite its early approachability will continue to reveal additional complexities for the next five to seven years.

Composition: 56% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Merlot, 11% Petit Verdot
